- Fundamental law drafted
- Freedom of Press restricted
- Control of university
- Show trials, executions
- Property of elites seized
- Control of labor unions
- One-Party State → Cuban Communist Party 1965
(1961 merge of guerilla army with communist party)
- opponents to communism within 26.J.M. arrested

→ nationalisation of foreign businesses & banks

→ pulled American support out
pushed Cuba towards USSR
